

KANSAS CITY – The law firms Paul McInnes LLP (<http://www.paulmcinnes.com>), Weinhaus & Potashnick(<http://www.fairwagelawyers.com>), and Heninger Garrison Davis LLC(<http://www.hgdllawfirm.com>) have filed a lawsuit against PJ United LLC, a franchisee of Papa John’s pizza restaurants operating in several states, for failing to pay minimum wage to its delivery drivers.

The suit alleges that PJ United violates federal wage and hour laws by failing to adequately reimburse its drivers for their automobile expenses, resulting in unreimbursed business expenses that reduce pizza delivery drivers’ net wages below minimum wage. The lawsuit was filed in Birmingham, Alabama. The driver who filed the lawsuit is seeking collective action status.

PJ United operates approximately 158 Papa John’s restaurants in Alabama, Louisiana, Texas, Mississippi, Tennessee, Illinois, Missouri, Ohio, Virginia, and Utah.
